

If you enjoy biking, running or strolling along scenic beaches, or exploring quaint harbor towns, then Holland should be your next trail vacation destination. The greater Holland area boasts the most extensive network of paved trails we've seen yet in the Great Lake State, allowing you to ride from Holland State Park along Lake Macatawa to Saugatuck Dunes State Park and the Village of Saugatuck on one continuous series

The Holland Shoreline Trail (around Lake Macatawa) connects many of the metro area's most popular city, county and state parks and scenic areas, including Holland State Park, Dunton Park and Kollen Park. Window on the Waterfront Park offers scenic views of Windmill Island and the Macatawa Natural Area. Ride the trail west along Adams Road to connect with the Upper Macatawa Greenway Trail.

The Beeline Trail travels south from Holland to Saugatuck where you can ride sections of the new Blue Star Trail along Blue Star Highway. Currently under development, the Blue Star Trail is a visionary trail project that will eventually connect Saugatuck with the Kal-Haven Trail in South Haven. Learn more at: www.fotbst.org
